

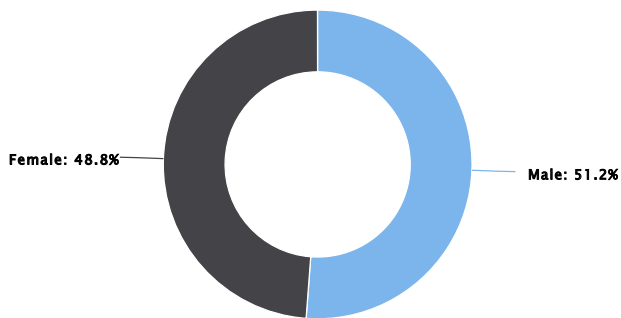

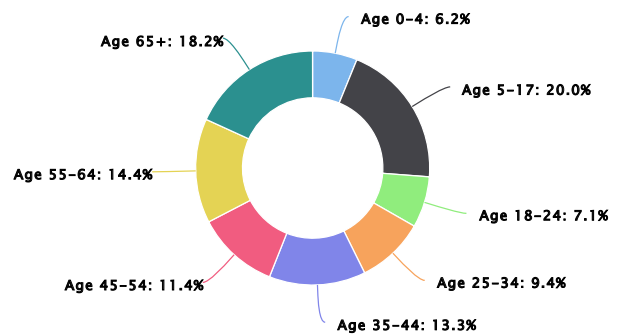

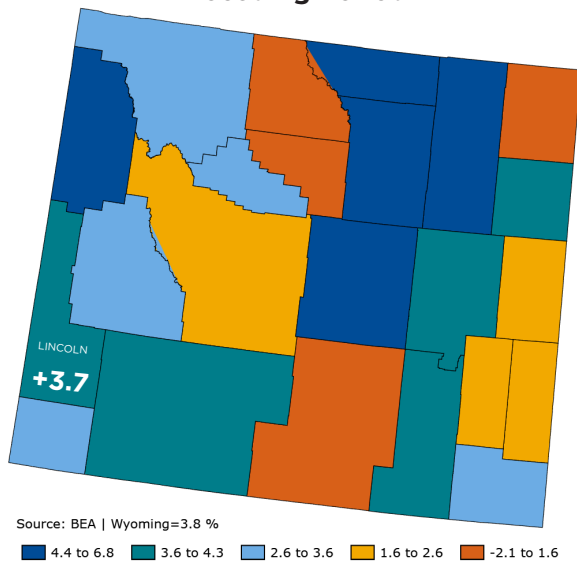


Total Population by Age Groups, Total

Employment 2021 - 2022, % Change From Preceding Period

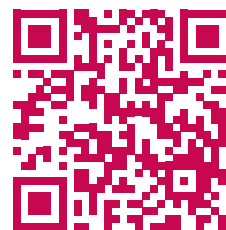

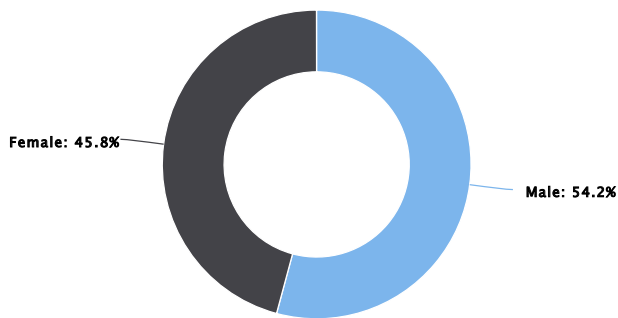

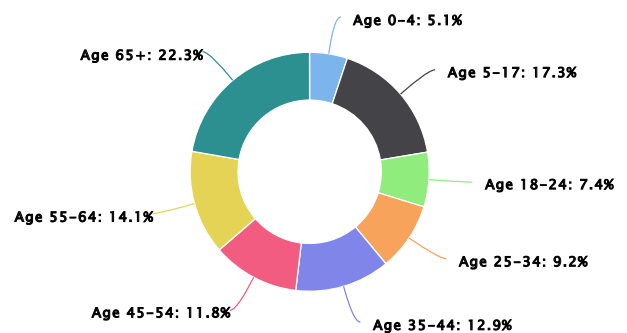

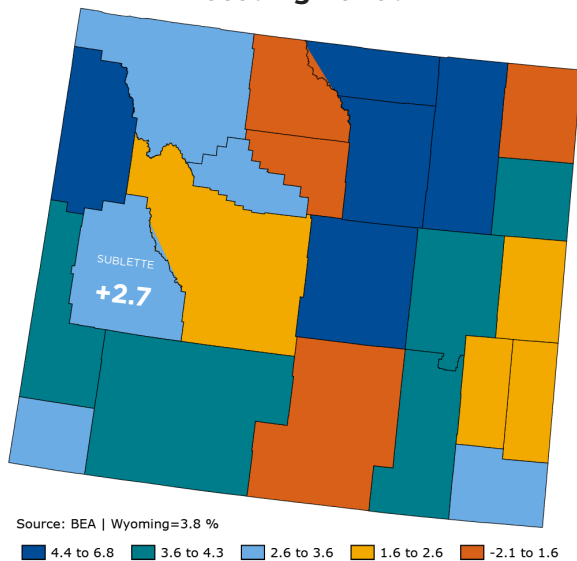


Total Population by Age Groups, Total

Employment 2021 - 2022, % Change From Preceding Period

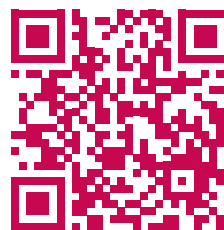
